



ATHLETE TRAVEL POLICY

Throughout the outdoor and indoor season athletes may have the opportunity to travel to meets outside of the metro area or throughout the U.S. This travel is not mandatory and **not** included in your MNF membership fees.

Out of state meets may include, but are not limited to:

- USATF Junior Olympic Regional and National Track and Field Championships
- USATF Youth Outdoor Championships
- USATF U20 National Meet
- AAU Junior Olympic Regional and National Meets
- SPIRE Showcase (Ohio)
- New Balance National Indoor/Outdoor
- Simplot Games (Idaho)

MNF makes every effort to keep travel cost affordable for anyone who qualifies and chooses to go, and will help arrange for transportation and lodging. Travel and cost details regarding these meets are provided each season.

Athlete Travel Policy Requirements:

Any athlete traveling with the team must commit to travel by the team's deadline, be on time for all events and activities, and adhere to the athlete code of conduct.

Athletes traveling with a parent/guardian will be responsible for all travel costs. Participation in team meals is optional for athletes and their families. Athletes may arrange to travel with another family, but MNF will not be responsible for athlete chaperoning, transportation, lodging, or meals.

Unaccompanied Athletes. Athletes who aren't able to travel with a parent/guardian and are at least 14 years-old, will be chaperoned by the team as long as parent/guardian have completed all waivers, have participated in meetings and discussions about the travel, have provided emergency contact information, and have paid all meet and travel fees in full prior to travel. Scholarship athletes, your scholarship does not cover costs of travel. There will be reconciliation at the end of the travel and any excess payment will be returned. Unaccompanied athletes are expected to assist the team at the meet and/or at the hotel.

We appreciate your understanding and adherence to this policy to ensure safe and affordable travel for all on our team.
